HUD Multifamily Housing Automation Rule

What is the Automation Rule?
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TRACS stands for **Tenant Rental Assistance Certification System**. It involves submitting 50059 and HAP information to HUD electronically.

Access for TRACS is through the HUD Secure System website.

The Tenant Rental Assistance Certification System (TRACS) is designed to process:

- Subsidy contracts;
- Tenant rental assistance information, and
- Owner requests for payment (vouchers).

TRACS collects tenant data and voucher data for project-based programs and authorizes payment for subsidy programs. Payments are based upon the voucher, contract, and tenant data residing in the system.

	iMAX is a web-based communication system that provides Contract Administrators (CAs), Owners, Management Agents, and Service Bureaus who have subsidy contracts with HUD to transmit to HUD.		
	Files sent to HUD are logged, processed, and submitted to TRACS for payment processing by iMAX. IMAX also receives TRACS processing results and makes these results available to the external business partners of HUD.

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Monthly Activity Transmission (MAT)

The Monthly Activity Transmission (MAT) is a front-end subsystem of TRACS.

It accepts data transmitted from the sites to HUD Headquarters or Contract Administrator in an electronic form and returns messages from HUD Headquarters or Contract Administrator to the sender sites.


MAT performs formatting and data-type validation on the data. MAT will return a file to the sender containing error messages when errors exist. The sender must correct the errors and resubmit the information.

All error messages are automatically returned via the sender's iMAX account, and users should review the contents of their mailbox daily.

Registration is required prior to gaining access to the Tenant Rental Assistance Certification System (TRACS) Internet applications. As these applications provide access to sensitive financial	
and personal information, security features have been implemented to ensure access is granted only to authorized entities/individuals.	
Only after registering in HUD's Secure Systems, being added to the system, receiving a user ID, and being assigned a system role can an internet user access TRACS internet applications.
